**Line of Ordination of Oscar A. Kirkham to the Office of Seventy, and
 One of the First Seven Presidents of Seventy**

Oscar A. Kirkham was ordained a Seventy on February 26, 1906, by Jos. W. McMurrin, who was ordained a Seventy Apr. 21, 1884, by Royal Barney, who was ordained a Seventy in 1835, under the hands of Jos. Smith and Sidney Rigdon. Sidney Rigdon was ordained as First Counselor in the Presidency on Mar. 18, 1833, by Joseph Smith. Jos. W. McMurrin was ordained one of the First Seven Presidents of Seventy on January 21, 1898, by Anthon H. Lund, who was ordained an Apostle on Oct. 7, 1889, by Geo. Q. Cannon.

Oscar A. Kirkham was set apart as one of the First Seven Presidents of Seventy on Oct. 18, 1941, by President Heber J. Grant, who was ordained an Apostle by Geo. Q. Cannon on October 16, 1882, who was ordained an Apostle by Brigham Young on August 26, 1860, who was ordained an Apostle under the hands of the Three Witnesses of the Book of Mormon, Oliver Cowdery, David Whitmer and Martin Harris, on February 14, 1835, and the ordination was confirmed at the same time by the First Presidency of the Church, then Joseph Smith, Jr., Sidney Rigdon and Frederick G. Williams. (See Comprehensive History of the Church, Century 1, Vol. 1, Chapter 30, and footnotes.) Joseph Smith was ordained an Apostle under the hands of Peter, James and John, in June, 1829. Peter, James and John were ordained by the Lord Jesus Christ. (St. John XV.)
